he Welcome Wagon		
In this activity, students will create their very own Welcome Wagon, where they can store all of their words and phrases to welcome and invite others to play with them!		
1	Hand out paper and art supplies. The supplies can be simply paper and something to write and draw with, or they can include markers, pipe cleaners, construction paper, glue, and glitter—the works!	
2	Instruct students to create their own unique welcome wagon. It can be any shape and size, color, or texture that they'd like.	
3	Once they have created their wagon, have students work together as a class, in small groups, or inde- pendently to brainstorm a list of welcome words. These words and phrases will help students welcome and invite their classmates to play with them or join their group.	
4	When the brainstorming is complete, have students or groups share their work with each other. If time allows, they can role-play some of the phrases they came up with to further practice their cooperation skills!
